Building Learning Powers

We will continue to develop and embed 'learning powers' into our curriculum this year to foster a love of learning, develop good learning habits and prepare children for a lifetime of learning. These learning powers will permeate through all subjects and encourage the children to think about themselves as learners, reflect on their learning journey and take responsibility for becoming a better learner. As last year we have chosen the learning power 'managing distractions' for the autumn term. This is part of being a resilient learner. Teachers will help the children to learn and recognise the techniques needed to manage their learning and support them to develop these skills. The learning power focus of the half term will also be recognised within our certificate assemblies.


tuition for pupils at your child's school (existing students please disregard) Beginning this term, a limited number of spaces will become available for group guitar

KEY INFORMATION

- Lessons are 30 minutes long and take place during the school day.
- . Lessons take place on a set day of the week at each school. We will confirm prior to the lessons beginning, which day they will take place at your child's school
- Lessons are ongoing throughout the school year.
- . Each group usually contains between 3-5 students.
- Lessons are £5.95 per student, but fees are invoiced on a termly (5-7 weeks) basis
- There is a one-off joining fee of £5.95, which covers the cost of all the resources your child will be given over the course of their tuition
- Students can borrow a guitar in school for their lesson, but we advise they purchase their own instrument at some point, so they are able to practice at home
