What happens when I start at Christleton Primary School?

Your teachers will help you to remember to use the toilet by reminding you before snack and break times.

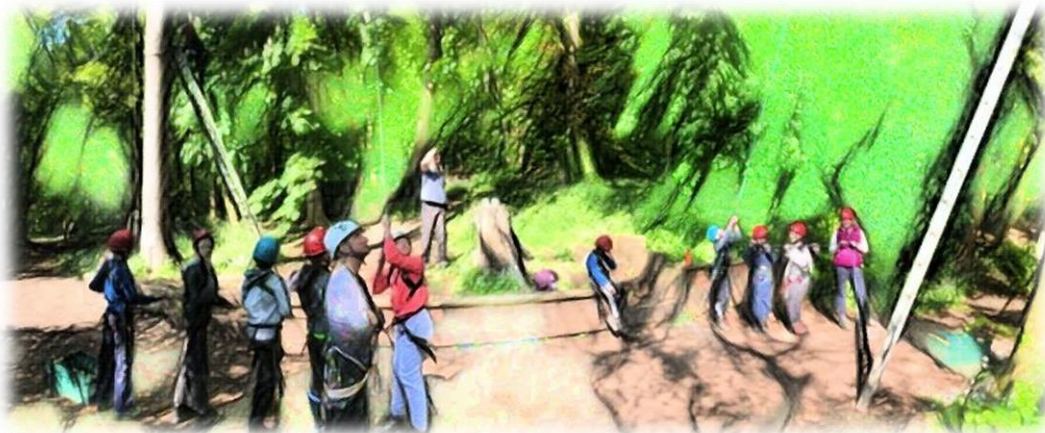
Will I like coming to Christleton Primary School?
