






# Year 1 Forest School Knowledge Organiser

<p>Loppers Usage To cut twigs larger than a penny piece.</p> <p>Key parts Handles, blades.</p> <p>How to use</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use tool two arms length and a tool away from others apart from partner.</li> <li>• Use like scissors.
